Paragraph 300 of St. Faustina's Diary says "Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment," and again in paragraph 1109, "I want to grant complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy."

Paragraph 699 says, "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are open all the divine floodgates through which graces flow."

What a gift Jesus is extending to us! Placing complete trust in Him with open hearts and hands we are offered these extraordinary graces as we receive His Body in the Eucharist on Divine Mercy Sunday.
